INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St Louis County Sheriff's Office and the Breitung Township Police Department responded to a report of a boating accident Friday evening, July 12th. A witness reported a boat struck Spider Island on the Tower end of Lake Vermilion, that the occupants were thrown from the boat, that they were unhurt and that they had been drinking. The boat occupants, both 24 year-old males, one from Virginia, one from Tower, were located unharmed and taken into custody. The boat operator was jailed in Virginia on a charge of Second Degree Driving While Impaired and the other occupant is expected to be charged with violating the terms of his probation.
