INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St Louis County Sheriff's Office is investigating a burglary which occurred at the McKinley City Hall and Library in the City of McKinley during the early morning hours of Sunday, September 1st. Cash, computers, wireless equipment and books were taken after several windows were broken to gain entry. With the assistance of citizens, a suspect was identified, a search warrant executed at a nearby home and the stolen items, with the exception of the cash, recovered. Area law enforcement agencies are assisting the Sheriff's Office with searching for the suspect.
