### INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St Louis County Sheriff's Volunteer Rescue Squad was called Monday evening to search for an elderly rural Orr resident who failed to return home from checking his traps in the Ash Lake area 12 miles north of the City of Orr. The search was made more urgent because near-zero temperatures were expected to settle in overnight.

The male, 80 years of age, was eventually found by Boise Inc. foresters late in the evening on a remote road where his truck had gotten stuck. He was unharmed.

The Minnesota State Patrol Air Wing assisted in the search.
