## INCIDENT SUMMARY:

A two vehicle crash occurred at the intersection of Midway Rd and Old Hwy 61 in Midway Township this afternoon. A 2011 Ford Super Duty pickup, driven by Brett Hagen, failed to stop for a stop sign while east bound on Old Hwy 61. As Hagen went across Midway Rd he was struck by Tanya Prachar, driving a 2014 Ford Fusion. Prachar was transported to St. Luke's Hospital by ambulance and is currently in stable condition. Both vehicles were totaled. There were no passengers in either vehicle. Hagen was cited for failure to stop at a stop sign. It appears he was unfamiliar with the area.

Crash remains under investigation by the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office.
