### INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Sunday night at around 11 PM, the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office responded to a burglary in progress at the Ainsworth plant in Angora Township. Upon arrival deputies surrounded the building and 1 suspect exited the building where he was confronted by deputies. He fled back into the building and within seconds, he and another suspect fled out of building from a back door. One suspect was apprehended after a short foot chase. The other was tracked by the Sheriff's Office K-9 Louie where he was apprehended a short time later hiding near a large drainage ditch. Both suspects are in custody and face burglary and obstructing charges.
