INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On 10/19 at around 10:43 AM, the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office responded to a one vehicle rollover on Hwy 5 in Lavell Township. A septic pumper tank had rolled over into the ditch. Driver Kent Nelson was traveling south on Hwy 5 when he swerved to avoid hitting a deer while driving his septic pumper truck. He swerved over to the shoulder area where he was unable to correct his driving path and went into the ditch and rolled over. No spills occurred. Driver Kent Nelson was taken by ambulance to UMCM Hospital in Hibbing with non-life threatening injuries. The incident remains under investigation at this time.
