## INCIDENT SUMMARY: Snowmobile Accident

The Saint Louis County Sheriff's Office responded to a snowmobile accident that occurred on the Arrowhead Snowmobile Trail approximately 10 miles North of Cook, Mn. Vivian KEC was operating her snowmobile along with 7 others in her party when she failed to negotiate a curve in the trail and struck a tree. KEC was transported by Life Link III air medical to a Duluth area Hospital in serious condition. KEC was wearing a helmet at the time of the accident and alcohol was not a factor.
