BUDGET PLAN

St. Louis County has proposed a budget that reflects its focus on balancing the needs of county residents with the resources available. Given the county's financial strength, economic conditions for residents affected by the mining industry, and the impact of the Transportation Sales Tax, St. Louis County's Commissioners and staff worked to achieve a 0% increase in property tax levy for 2016.
