

Pesticides: Agricultural and Businesses – Improper use and disposal of pesticides can cause damage to your health and the environment.

Reduce – Avoid using them as much as possible. When you do use them, do so carefully for their intended purpose according to label directions. Use custom application to avoid having any unused pesticides on your farmstead. Use mini-bulk systems to reduce the number of pesticide containers needing disposal.

Recycle – Empty, triple-rinsed containers will be collected at pesticide container collections. Call the Minnesota Extension Service for information 218-749-7120.

Disposal – Collection of unused farm pesticides will likely be available every two years. Call the Minnesota Extension Service at 218-749-7120 or the [Household Hazardous Waste Facility](#) at 218-741-8831 for information. Empty containers can be triple-rinsed and disposed of as industrial solid waste.

Pesticides: From Household Use – Herbicides, insecticides, rodenticides and fungicides.

Reduce – Avoid using pesticides whenever possible. When you do use them, do so carefully for their intended purpose according to label directions. Share leftovers with others.

Disposal – If you have pesticides that you cannot use, take them to a [Household Hazardous Waste](#) collection site.
