

The St. Louis County Surveyors Office does not have GPS coordinates for property corners. We do have coordinates for about 20% of the section and quarter corners in the County. This information can be found at:

#### HELPFUL HINTS:

From the "Overlay layers" menu on the left, turn on: "Lakes/River" and "Roads"  
(this will show lakes and rivers)

-Note: when not zoomed in close enough, not all selected items may show up on your screen.

-Note: if at any time you make a new selection or a selection change and the screen does not reflect this request, select from the top toolbar "Refresh the map".

Zoom in on St. Louis County.

Zoom in closer to your area of interest.

Again from the "Overlay layers" menu on the left, turn on: "Public Land Survey"  
(this will show approximate section lines)

-Note: the "Public Land Survey" option may not be available to select until you zoom in close enough.

From the "Background Layers" menu on the left, turn on "2008 Color Aerial Photos"  
(This will show an aerial photo view – you may want to turn off "Lakes/River")

Now if you place your cursor on the map image, its coordinates will be shown on the bottom of the page – both in UTM and Latitude and Longitude.
