Given a verbal checkout with an evaluator, describe safe behaviors for working around an active helicopter Landing Zone (LZ). Do you have any questions?

Task	Go	No-Go
States staying clear of the LZ until the ship has safely landed and idled down		
States only entering and leaving from the front and sides, never from the rear		
States only entering and leaving upon signal from the flight crew		
States staying low, and keeping objects low (like IV bags)		
States turning ballcaps around backwards or removing them altogether		
Describes hazard areas, including tail rotor, pitot tubes, and exhaust ports		
States staying clear of the LZ until well after the helicopter has departed in case the ship needs to return for an emergency landing		

Critical Criteria

Check if Go; Circle if No-Go

- Must state only approaching and leaving from the front and sides; never the rear
- Must describe avoiding hazards of tail rotor, pitot tubes, and exhaust ports
- Must acknowledge only entering or leaving upon signal from the flight crew
