**W-101, Identify and State Nomenclature of Watercraft**

During an equipment walkaround with an evaluator, describe the common name, length, and storage location of every watercraft in your local office. *Example: The Crestliner is a 20-foot general purpose boat currently docked in Riverside. **NOTES TO EVALUATOR:**

Accompany the candidate on a walkaround of the garage area. In summer months (South Office only), a short follow-up road patrol to the marina and Coast Guard station will finish off the walkaround; while in winter months, you'll have to drive to our storage warehouse. The candidate should tell you the common name of each craft (even if they read it off the side, that's okay), and tell you where it's stored, as well as the length and whether it holds a special mission. Score them a No-Go if they get more than one wrong. Be sure to make allowances for "old data," and make an on-the-spot correction if they cite an old location for a boat that has been recently relocated.

Task	Go	No-Go
Identifies Crestliner (20-footer), Aluma-craft (19-footer) and Alaskan (19-footer)		
Identifies Red Zodiac, "Baby-Z," and the Zodiac atop the Water Rescue Trailer		
Identifies Boston Whaler (25-footer), and gives current location, citing "big-water" mission		
Identifies Hoover 1 (yellow, 4-person hovercraft) and Hoover 2 (white, 3-person)		
Identifies black bucket sled and blue water rescue sled in Water Rescue Trailer
