## INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Shortly before noon on April 27, Charles Lutkevich called 911 to report his wife was missing. Charles stated his wife, Sharon Lutkevich 68 years old, suffers from dementia. She went for a walk this morning near her home on W Beyer Rd in Rice Lake Township, but has not returned. An extensive search is currently underway. The St. Louis County Sheriff's Rescue Squad is asking for help from the public in locating Sharon. Sharon walks with a slight shuffle or limp and was last scene wearing black workout pants, a grey UMD sweatshirt, and light blue tennis shoes. She is 5'2" with shoulder length gray hair (see attached photo). If you may have seen Sharon today please call 911 or 218-727-8770. Thank You.
