## INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St. Louis County Volunteer Rescue Squad and Orr Fire Department responded to Black Duck lake located approximately 15 miles North of Orr on a report that 2 snowmobilers had become stuck in some slush out on the lake. David Ramola and Glenn Law were part of a group of 5 riding snowmobiles on Black Duck Lake when the two of them became stuck in some slush. The three other riders made it back to their cabin and called 911 for help. Ramola and Law were able to free themselves from the slush and made their way to an unoccupied cabin to seek shelter from the weather. The St. Louis County Volunteer Rescue Squad used their Marsh Master Vehicle to maneuver across the lake and located Ramola and Law at the cabin. Ramola and Law were attended to by ORR EMS and released without any further medical treatment.
