INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St. Louis County Sheriff's Office responded to an ATV accident that occurred near 1175 Hwy 5 which is located approximately 15 miles West of Cook, Mn. Terry Treloar was the operator of a Can-Am side by side ATV and his wife Joann Treloar was his passenger. Terry and Joann were both injured after their ATV rolled over in a field. Terry and Joann were both transported by ambulance to the Fairview Range Medical Center in Hibbing, and Joann was later air lifted by Life Link 3 Helicopter to Essentia Health-St. Mary's Medical Center in Duluth in critical condition. Terry suffered non life threatening injuries. Alcohol appears to be a factor and the accident remains under investigation by the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office.
