INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St Louis County Sheriff's Volunteer Rescue Squad, U.S. Forest Service law enforcement officers and a Forest Service canine were called Friday evening to assist St Louis County deputies with locating Jonathan Pruse, 39, of Silver Bay, after he crashed his vehicle on Townline Road in east-central St Louis County and was thought to have possibly become lost in the woods nearby. Weather conditions were deteriorating and darkness had fallen, causing concern for Pruse's well-being.

Pruse was eventually located just after midnight by a Forest Service officer and transported to Essentia Health Northern Pines in Aurora for treatment of hypothermia and later released.
