INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St. Louis County Sheriff's Office received a report of a fire at the old Ainsworth property (which was formerly the Potlatch complex) approximately 5 miles south of Cook, Mn in rural Angora Twp. The abandoned facility is currently in the process of being salvaged by a local company. It appears the fire was in a pit inside of a building on the property. The cause of the fire remains under investigation, and the extent of the damage is not known at this time as the fire is still being actively fought by several area volunteer fire departments.
