Tuesday, July 23, 2:00 -4:00 p.m.

Bring any easy food item you are able to prepare by yourself or with a little help from your parents or older brother or sister. Example: Peanut butter and jelly sandwich. **And/or** Bring a decorated cookie or cupcake. Bring a recipe for the item you made. Example: 2 pieces of wheat bread, 1 Tbsp. Smooth peanut butter, 1 Tbsp. Grape jelly. Plan a simple menu to go with your food. Example: Peanut butter and jelly sandwich, glass of 2% milk, ½ banana. You will have an opportunity to discuss your choices and hear other cloverbuds discuss theirs. You can also bring a cookie or cupcake you decorated.
