ST. LOUIS COUNTY SOLID WASTE SERVICE FEES

The St. Louis County Solid Waste Service Fee was instituted in 1991. Prior to that, all fees for solid waste were derived from tax levies.

Service fees are applied on all parcels with \$1000.00 or more in improvements.

In 1991, the Service Fee paid for all solid waste activities (landfill and transfer station operations, recycling, household hazardous waste, etc.).

**In 1991 and 1992, no tipping fees were charged at any facility.

In 1993, the Service Fees were split: **Service Fees and **Tipping Fees**.

Service Fees pay for administration, recycling, household hazardous waste, special waste (appliances, batteries, scrap metal, tires, motor oil, filters, etc.).

Tipping Fees pay for disposal of waste by the ton or by the cubic yard, and also pays for landfill and transfer station operations and waste haulage.
