Boldface portions of each entry denote how the road is commonly referenced. Obviously, you are free to use the highway numbers and symbols in both the map and road patrol sections of this module. However, the boldface entries are the "testable" items of the practical checkout. For example, no one will quiz on what the road number is for the Maple Grove Road, but you should be able to locate the Rice Lake Road or Industrial Road given only "Highway 4," and "Highway 7," respectively. *NOTE: Each list is different! While they share common items, each list contains items not present on the other. Read carefully!*

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PART B: During a road patrol in a vehicle with an evaluator, drive to the locations on the list below.

NOTE: This module will require considerable practice. Don't feel bad if you are unable to visit all locations your first time out.

EVAULATOR'S NOTES: The candidate should be familiar enough with the list from their independent study that they identify a majority of the items from memory as you arrive there. After a couple of hours of driving around, checking off items from memory, the candidate might ask, "what do I have left?" Feel free at this time to suggest routes that will knock off the remaining items. DO NOT allow the candidate to proceed in list order, or it will take you months to finish! Obviously, the goal of this module is the candidate knowing the county, NOT merely checking items off on a list. To this end, one indicator of this knowledge is that the candidate will frequently point out roads that are NOT on the list. Encourage this by occasionally asking, "Where are we now?" and "Where are we going?"
