NOTES TO EVALUATOR:

While all criteria are on-the-spot correctable by themselves, the candidate should complete the checkout with no more than two mistakes. Score the candidate a No-Go if he or she misses more than two items.

Task	Go	No-Go
Locates master power switch (if equipped)		
Identifies ignition key, describes key positions; describes throttle and choke positions for cold and warm starting		
Locates and describes controls for radio; demonstrates adjusting volume and frequency		
Locates and describes controls for depth sounder; demonstrates changing zoom		
Locates and demonstrates navigational and emergency lights		
Describes placement of fenders and mooring lines		
Describes and demonstrates (simulation okay) connecting fuel lines; demonstrates (simulation okay) priming for initial start following refueling		
Locates bilge plug; states ensuring plug is secured before launching		
Locates accessory equipment, including PFD's, hand lanterns, drag bars, hooks, pike poles, anchors, and line		
Identifies/locates/describes use of power tilt or trim (if equipped)		
Describes/demonstrates positioning of motor for launch/trailing
