## **Water Event Permit**

The following information is required to process your application for a Water Event Permit. (Required by Minn. State Statute, Chapter 86B.121). This form should be sent to the Sheriff's Office at least 30 days prior to the event. Note: The county's issuance of a permit under this section does not make the county liable for any injury occurring at the event.

## **Water Event Permit (continued)**

Event applicant will insure the following guidelines will be met:

Signature of Organizer:

- 1. Sufficient off-road parking will be provided for participants and spectators. Adequate traffic direction will be provided to these parking areas.
- 2. Reasonable security for the event will be provided by the race organizer/permit applicant so as to insure the safety of persons and property in the event area.
- 3. Organizer will provide sanitation facilities, in sufficient quantity for persons present.
- 4. Medical/First Aid facilities as needed and practical for the event should be made available on site.
- 5. Organizer/permit applicant will insure that all litter and debris left in the event area as a result of the event, shall be removed within 48 hours after the completion of the event. failure to remove litter or debris will result in the issuance of a citation for littering to the organizer.
- 6. If the event is to be held on ice, the event organizer will insure that the ice is of sufficient thickness to support participants, spectators, and equipment. Additionally, lake surface areas must be returned to original condition following the event (such as removal of snowbanks, etc caused by the event).
- 7. Organizer will consider the safety of participants and spectators to be of primary importance and will conduct the event with this factor in mind. If the Sheriff or his designee determine that the event is not being conducted safely, this permit will be made invalid.

Event organizer should understand that St. Louis County assumes no liability for personal injury or property damage resulting from the operation of snowmobiles, water craft, or other vehicles; nor provide event insurance coverage; or provide the necessary safety precautions for spectators or participants.

If approved, the Sheriff or his designee will sign and date this document which will serve as the Water Event Permit.
