Notice of State General Election: November 3, 2020. All persons registered to vote on October 6, 2020 in MAIL BALLOT precincts will automatically be sent a ballot at least 14 days prior to the election. If you are registered to vote and do not receive a ballot by October 27, 2020, please contact the Auditor's Office at one of the locations listed below.

Voted ballots may be returned by mail (stamped return envelopes are included with each MAIL BALLOT packet) or in person at one of the below listed locations. Ballots returned by mail, must be postmarked on or before Election Day (November 3, 2020) and received by the Auditor's Office within the next seven calendar days (November 10, 2020). Ballots returned in person, must be received by the Auditors Office no later than 3:00 p.m. on Election Day (November 3, 2020). Assistive voting equipment is available at the Auditor's Office.

NOTE: If you live in one of the mail ballot areas and are eligible to vote but are not currently registered, you may apply to the Auditor's Office in person or by mail for ballots and registration materials.
