Eligibility Guidelines

The worker's income must be at or below the amount provided below for an individual (household of 1) regardless of actual household size.

St. Louis County Income Limit for Fiscal Year 2022:	\$47,800
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Definitions for Housing and Community Development-funded Projects:

 \rightarrow <u>Section 3 Worker</u> – Any worker who currently meets, or when hired since November 30, 2020 met, one of the following criteria as documented:

- A low- or very low-income individual (the worker's income for the previous or annualized calendar year is below the income limit established by HUD); or
- A YouthBuild participant. or
- Employed by a Section 3 business concern. A Section 3 Business Concern is:
 - o 51% or more owned and controlled by low or very-low income persons, or
 - Over 75% of labor hours performed for the business over the prior three-month period are performed by Section 3 workers, or
 - 51% or more owned and controlled by current residents of public housing or Section 8assisted housing.

 \rightarrow <u>Targeted Section 3 Worker</u> – Any Section 3 Worker who currently meets, or when hired since November 30, 2020 met, one of the following criteria as documented:

- Employed by a Section 3 business concern, or
- Living within one mile of the service area or the neighborhood of the project
 - If fewer than 5,000 people live within one mile of a Section 3 project, within a circle centered on the Section 3 project that is sufficient to encompass a population of 5,000 people.
- A YouthBuild participant
