In order to assure effective recycling in St. Louis County, please follow these simple directions.

FLATTEN MATERIAL PRIOR TO STORAGE

EMPTY BAGS OF MATERIAL IN THE APPROPRIATE BIN

PLACE PAPER BAGS WITH PAPER

Special Waste Recycling Programs

Residents may bring the following materials to one of the County Solid Waste sites for FREE! Per trip:

- 2 Appliances
- 8 Tires/Day
- 6 Four ft. Fluorescent Tubes and CLFs/Load
- 6 Drained Oil Filters/Load
- Used Oil, Auto Batteries and Antifreeze
- Scrap Metal
- Yard Waste, Brush and Branches

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Residential HHW can be brought to one of two County facilities:

Regional Landfill, Virginia
Tuesdays and Saturdays
8am – 1pm

Hibbing Transfer Station
Saturdays
8am – 1pm

AT HOME

- ACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLES ONLY
- Flatten and cut cardboard 2'x 2'
- Keep all loose material contained in a bag
- Recycle all mixed newspaper, magazines, "junk" mail, and boxboard
