Contractor Training Session

The Land & Minerals Department will be conducting gravel contractor sessions this winter and spring. All vendors anticipating purchasing gravel in 2020, are encouraged to attend.

This session will satisfy training requirements for multiple purchases throughout the year.

Responsible Operators List

The Land and Minerals Department has certified its lands as managed under the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) program. As part of the process, all field operators who purchase the right to extract a resource from St. Louis County lands are required to be on our Responsible Operators List.

Forms for the Responsible Operator's List will be at the meeting for you.

Certificate of Insurance

Be sure to bring the Certificate of Insurance with you; however, this can also be submitted just prior to obtaining a gravel permit. We request that St. Louis County Land and Minerals Department be identified as the certificate



holder on the liability policy. You may also notify your Insurance Company to fax your Certificate of Insurance to your local St. Louis County Land and Minerals Office:
