

St. Louis County Public Health Achievement Awards

The St. Louis County Board and Public Health and Human Services Department each year recognize and honor community organizations, businesses or residents who demonstrate a commitment to improving the health of individuals, families and communities in St. Louis County. The Public Health Achievement Awards will be presented during the St. Louis County Board meeting on Tuesday, April 14, 2020.

Selection Criteria

Nominations will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

Leadership – Nominee has demonstrated leadership abilities through work and service.

Public Health Contributions – Nominee has demonstrated originality and innovation in creating solutions to public health problems and has contributed to advancing improvements in the health status of the community through work and service.

Community Health Improvement – The activities of the nominee have contributed to successful outcomes, bringing positive change and improving the health status of the community.

Collaboration – Nominee has promoted collaboration and cooperation among individuals, organizations, agencies and the people served by the St. Louis County Public Health Division.

Advocacy – Nominee has been involved in promoting health and healthy behaviors, and/or protecting the health and safety of County residents.

Nomination Instructions

- ❖ Nominations must be typed and should be no more than two pages in length. Two attachments may accompany the nomination form (reference letters, newspaper articles, etc.). Photographs that show individual or group involvement and achievements can be used.
- ❖ Nominations must describe public health contributions made within the previous two years and describe the improvements made on the selected public health issue.
- ❖ A nomination form may be completed by an individual or group. Individuals or groups may submit more than one nomination or nominate themselves.
- ❖ Nominations and attachments become the property of St. Louis County Public Health.
- ❖ Awards are intended for individuals and organizations that are not part of St. Louis County Public Health.
