The Minnesota Department of Public Safety, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, will be on site in St. Louis County to conduct a Preliminary Damage Assessment. All eligible applicants will be able to complete the request for assistance forms and sit down with MN HSEM to discuss their damages.

Eligible applicants need to bring the following information with them:

- Location map of their jurisdiction with the damage locations marked on it
- Photos of damaged area(s)
- Estimates of the cost to repair
- Bring invoices or proof of costs for repairs already completed
- Repair schedule will be discussed for work not yet completed
- Documentation will be collected at this meeting
