INCIDENT SUMMARY:

St. Louis County Sheriff's Office responded to a snowmobile accident involving two snowmobiles. Husband and wife were riding on trails in Gnesen township, returning from the Vintage Run on Fish Lake. The husband lost control of his machine taking a left corner of the trail and rolled his snowmobile. Victim's wife who was riding behind him on her own snowmobile, came around the corner, observed her husband laying on the trail. The victims wife applied the throttle instead of the brake which resulted in her crashing into her husband. He complained of back and neck injuries and she was treated for an injury to her right leg. They were both treated by Gnesen First Responders, EMS and St. Louis Co. Rescue Squad and then transported to St. Mary's Hospital by ambulance. The machines they were using were borrowed and the riders were inexperienced to those specific machines.
