INCIDENT SUMMARY:

A 34 YOA Duluth man going southbound on Jean Duluth in his Dodge Truck collided with a 26 YOA Lakewood man going westbound on Riley Road in his Chevrolet Blazer. Eyewitnesses said after the collision both vehicle went airborne into the south west ditch, rolling over, coming to a rest on their sides. The driver of the Dodge Truck walked away from the accident, and the driver of the Chevrolet Blazer was transported by Gold Cross Ambulance to the hospital. The driver of the Blazer was alert and talking at the scene of the accident, but the extent of his injuries are currently unknown. Preliminary indications are that the Chevrolet Blazer pulled out in front of the Dodge Truck. The accident is under investigation by the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office.
