INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On 5/30/2013 at approx. 3:17 AM, the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office received a call of an overdue male who had been hiking on the Sioux Hustler Trail, which is located off of the Echo Trail. The hiker, Daniel Oberg, had been hiking the trail on 5/29/13 and advised family he would be home later that night. When Oberg failed to return home they became concerned and contacted the Sheriff's Office for assistance. The St. Louis Co. Sheriff's Rescue Squad was contacted and responded to begin searching for Oberg. At approx. 8:20 AM on 5/30/13, Oberg emerged from the woods on his own and was uninjured. Due to poor weather during the evening/night, Oberg decided to camp out overnight and hike out in the morning.
