INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On 6/25/2013, at approx. 12:55 PM St. Louis Co. dispatch received a report of a seaplane that crashed into Shagawa Lake (Olson's Bay area of lake). Investigation revealed the plane was piloted by Timothy Breuhl with his wife, Judy, being the only passenger. Breuhl was in the process of landing the float plane on Shagawa Lake when the accident occurred. Both Breuhl's were uninjured and were assisted off the plane by a nearby boater. The airplane, a 2000 Aviat Husky model plane with floats sustained major damage. The accident remains under investigation by the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office and the Federal Aviation Administration. The St. Louis County Rescue Squad is currently assisting in removing the plane from the lake.
