INCIDENT SUMMARY:

A structure fire was reported at 2893 Lismore Road in Normanna Township. It appears that the fire was started under suspicious circumstances and a female suspect was arrested and later hospitalized. The residence sustained heavy fire and water damage and a damage estimate is not currently available. Arson Investigators from the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office responded and are continuing their investigation into the fire. On 8-16-13 at 3:40 AM, the Normanna Township Fire Dept. again responded to the residence due to the fire re-starting, but it was quickly extinguished.
