INCIDENT SUMMARY:

St Louis County Deputies responded to a report of a one vehicle motorcycle accident. Fish was found by passers-by, laying in the East side ditch near a motorcycle. Indicators at the scene, show that Fish was Northbound on Rice Lake Rd in Gnesen Township, and it appears that he failed to negotiate a curve, struck two mail boxes, was thrown from the motorcycle and came to rest in the ditch. Fish sustained multiple injuries and was attended to by Gnesen Fire Dept. First Responders and Gold Cross Ambulance personnel. Fish was transported by Gold Cross Ambulance to St Lukes Hospital for possible, life threatening injuries. It is believed that Fish was wearing a helmet. Alcohol and excessive speed are believed to be possible contributing factors and the crash remains under investigation.
