### **Key dates to know for St. Louis County Second District special election**

With five weeks remaining until the special election to fill the Second District County Commissioner position, the St. Louis County Auditor offers some reminders to voters. The election will be Tuesday, January 14. Voters in the second district should go to their regular polling place to cast their ballot.

Absentee ballots are now available and can be cast in person through January 13 at the Duluth City Clerk's Office, Room 330 of Duluth City Hall. The City Clerk's Office is open Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., as well as Saturday, January 11, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Voters also may request an absentee ballot by mail by calling the City Clerk's Office at (218) 730-5500. Mailed ballots must be returned by January 14 in order to be counted.

Anyone in the district who is not already registered to vote may do so at the City Clerk's Office now through December 23. Voters may register at their polling site on election day if they provide one of the means of identification authorized by the Secretary of State, as is detailed online at [sos.state.mn.us](http://sos.state.mn.us).

The special election is to fill the seat formerly held by Steve O'Neil, who passed away last July from cancer. The two candidates advancing from the primary election, which was held in November, are Patrick Boyle and Jim Stauber. Results from the election are expected to be certified and the winner sworn in in time for the January 28, 2014, County Board meeting. The winning candidate will serve the remaining three years of O'Neil's term.
