INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On January 9th at approximately 0320 the St. Louis County Sheriff's Department responded to a residential fire in Clinton Township. Upon arrival the residence was fully engulfed and ended up being a total loss. A total of three adults, one child and two dogs were in the residence at the time of the fire. All three adults suffered burns, and the child and two dogs escaped without injuries. The three adults were transported by private vehicle to the Essentia Health Hospital in Virginia. The cause of the fire is unknown at this time and under investigation. The American Red Cross is assisting.
