INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St. Louis County Sheriff's Office is investigating a snowmobile accident with injury. Roger Anderson of Duluth was traveling across Caribou Lake, in Grand Lake Township, when he lost control of his snowmobile on the uneven snow and ice covered lake. Anderson was reportedly thrown from the snowmobile as it rolled over on the ice. Anderson sustained unknown, but non-life threatening injuries. Anderson was transported by Gold Cross Ambulance to a local hospital for treatment. Alcohol consumption is not a contributing factor in this case. The Sheriff's Office reminds all snowmobilers to exercise due care while riding over area lakes and streams.

Both the St. Louis County Volunteer Rescue Squad and the Grand Lake Volunteer Fire Department assisted with extricating the patient and snowmobile from the lake.
