Water recedes, allowing for roads to re-open, but new roads affected

High waters levels caused by rapidly melting snow have receded enough that all three roads closed last week in St. Louis County have now re-opened. County Road 200 in Meadowland Township, County Road 748 (Jones Road) in Great Scott Township and County Road 430 (Burghardt Road) in Angora Township have all re-opened to traffic.

However three new roads have been posted with warning signs due to water on the roadway. These roads are considered passable and remain open at this time. Signs are posted alerting motorists to use caution. They include:

- **CSAH 40 (North Tischer Road)** in Normanna Township approximately one mile north Lismore Road.
- **County Road 284 (Ugstad Road)** in Canosia Township approximately a half mile north of Martin Road.
- **County Road 859 (Caribou Lake Road)** in Solway Township approximately a quarter mile north of Helm Road.

An additional three roads, which had already been identified last week, continue to have signs posted alerting motorists to use caution.

- **Unorganized Township (UT) road 8114 (Brown Rd)** east of Angora Township, south of State Hwy 1.
- **CSAH 24** in Beatty Township, one quarter mile north of Kennedy Road.
- **County Road 431 (Vermilion Lake Road)** in Owens Township north of CSAH 115.

Conditions on all other roads identified last week have improved enough for signs to be removed. Public Works crews continue to monitor road conditions throughout the County. Anyone who encounters a dangerous road condition is asked to call 9-1-1.
