Phone Scam Notice

The St. Louis County Sheriff's Office in Hibbing has taken several complaints from the public who have received phone calls to send money out of the country to help their grand children in trouble. The person(s) conducting the scam have the elderly victim wire money to an out of country bank or get credit card information from the victim and conduct the scam/fraud with the use of the card information. The St. Louis County Sheriff's Office would like to remind the public that if they are requested to send money to a different country, it is most likely person(s) trying to conduct a scam/fraud. They should not comply with the request and notify their local law enforcement agency.
