AIRCRAFT CRASH

INCIDENT SUMMARY:

At 1124 on 7 June 2014, St. Louis County Dispatch received a call of a single engine aircraft that had taken off from the Duluth International Airport, had gone off the radar, and was believed to have crashed into Lake Superior. It is believed that the unidentified pilot was the only person in the aircraft and at this time, is unaccounted for.
