INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Two of the larger pieces of a single engine plane that crashed into Lake Superior on June 7th were recovered today. Members of the St. Louis County Sheriff's Volunteer Rescue Squad were assisted by divers from the Superior/Douglas County Dive Team as well as commercial divers. The sections were brought to the surface and removed from the water at the McQuade Safe Harbor. They had been in about 135 feet of water. The wreckage will be examined by officials from the FAA and NTSB who are working to determine a cause of the crash.
