Five-way intersection in West Duluth to temporarily close beginning Sept. 10

The five-leg intersection where Highland Street, Getchell Road, Vinland Street and Skyline Parkway all meet will be closed for three weeks, beginning September 10. It's the next phase of the \$10.7 million project to reconstruct Highland Street and 57th Avenue West. The intersection is being reconfigured into a standard, four-way intersection with turn lanes.

The three-week closure of the intersection will affect motorists traveling across Skyline Parkway, as well as anyone traveling two and from Proctor via Vinland Street and Getchell Road.

St. Louis County Public Works is reconstructing 1.5 miles of Highland Street and 57th Avenue West, which together make up County State Aid Highway 89. It is the last major road construction project linked to the June 2012 flood, and is expected to be done by the end of October.
