INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St. Louis County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to the report a house fire at a traumatic brain injury group home in Grand Lake Township. One staff member and one client were home at the time of the fire. The resident client had locked himself inside of his bedroom where the fire started. Both the staff member and the resident were outside on squads arrival. No one was injured in the fire. The resident was transported to St. Lukes Hospital for treatment of smoke inhalation. The house appears to be a total loss due to the fire. The fire is under investigation by the State Fire Marshall's Office and the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office.
