INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The St. Louis County Sheriff's Office responded to a medical/overdose incident with two patients on 2/27/15. This incident resulted in the death of a 42 year old female and medical treatment for a 60 year old male from a drug overdose believed to be as a result of opioid use.

The Sheriff's office would like to warn the public and any possible opioid users of these incidents due to the adverse effects from incidents throughout St. Louis County this past weekend.

Due to the unknown content of some of these drugs users run much higher risks of overdosing which can cause serious injury or death. One of the most common and popular opioid's is the drug know as Heroin. These incidents remain under investigation at this time.
