Road construction begins July 27 on CSAH 16 from Highway 4 to County line

Construction begins Monday, July 27, to resurface 24 miles of Town Line Road, also known as County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 16. It's the largest single paving project in County history, stretching from Highway 4 (Vermilion Trail) east to Fairbanks, ending at the border with Lake County. CSAH 16 is a significant route connecting the Iron Range to the North Shore.

The \$7.1 million construction project is being funded by the Transportation Sales Tax. The sales tax revenue accelerated this roadway improvement project by three years, enabling it to be completed during the 2015 construction season.

CSAH 16 will remain open to traffic throughout the project, which is expected to be completed in early September. However, motorists should expect delays due to temporary lane closures, as well as rough surfaces at times throughout this construction project.

Drivers are reminded to pay attention when traveling through this and all work zones, and to observe and follow flagger instructions, work zone speed limits and traffic control signage.
