## INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On 10/04/15 at 0433 hrs., the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office was assigned to investigate a capsized boat containing 3, 17 year old males on Fish Lake in Fredenberg Township. The juveniles were heading up the river on Fish Lake to duck hunt when their boat took on water and capsized. Two of the juveniles swam to shore using their decoys as flotation devices and the third juvenile hung onto the boat. Deputies with the use of a boat picked up all 3 males. Gold Cross Ambulance Service treated the juveniles and released them at the scene. There were flotation vests in the boat however, they were not worn by the juveniles. Two of the juveniles are Duluth residents and the other is from Wisconsin. This incident remains under investigation by the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office.
