INCIDENT SUMMARY: Snowmobile Accident

The Saint Louis County Sheriff's Office responded to a snowmobile accident that occurred on the Wolf Track snowmobile trail approximately 5 miles South East of Cook, Mn. Niles PINCHART was operating his snowmobile along with 2 other people in his party when he failed to negotiate a curve and jumped off of his snowmobile striking some trees. PINCHART was transported by the Cook ambulance to the Cook hospital with non-life threatening injuries.
