## INCIDENT SUMMARY: House Fire

On the above date and time, the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office responded to a remote cabin fire near the Hilda Creek off the Vermilion River in the Orr/Crane Lake area on the 4200 blk of Crane Lake Rd. (HWY 24) in unorganized township 46-17. The fire was spotted by a MN DNR plane in the area. The cabin was unoccupied at the time, however the cabin owners were nearby with no cellphone reception. The cabin was fully engulfed when discovered by the cabin owner and the MN DNR plane. The cabin and a sauna building were a total loss. The cause of the fire is unknown at this time and is being investigated by the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office.
