St. Louis County Assistant Attorney, Rebekka Stumme receives award

On Monday, December 17, 2012, St. Louis County Assistant Attorney Rebekka Stumme was presented a Certificate of Appreciation Award. The honor was given in gratitude for the dedication and service Stumme provided to the City of Proctor, Minnesota, during the trial of a vicious homicide which recently occurred within the city. Proctor Chief of Police, Walter C. Wobig, nominated Stumme for the award.

“While it required the assistance of many professionals and citizens to conclude the investigation, it was ultimately Ms. Stumme’s responsibility to put the matter before the jury,” said Wobig. As a result of Stumme’s skill and professionalism, the jury delivered a verdict of guilty and obtained justice for Dale Anderson, deceased, and the family he left behind.

The Award ceremony was held at the City Council Meeting, where Mayor David Brenna presented Stumme the award.

Stumme graduated from the University of Minnesota-Duluth, with a BA in political science in 1996, and from Hamline University School of Law in 1999. She worked for a civil law firm from 1999-2004 and for the Public Defender’s office from 2001-2010. In February of 2010, Stumme joined the St. Louis County Attorney’s office, where she has become known for successful prosecution of particularly complex criminal trials.
