Approximately eight committee meetings are held annually on the fourth Wednesday of the month from 9:00-11:00 a.m. at Cotton Town Hall.

TERM: Three (3) years expiring December 31, 2015.

QUALIFICATIONS: Resident of St. Louis County with an interest in planning educational programs brought to local people through the St. Louis County Extension Offices as an outreach of University of Minnesota Extension. This would include program development in areas such as community issues, economic diversification, nutrition and health, youth and families, horticulture, agronomy and specialty crop development and providing research-based information to the public on a wide variety of subject matters.

FUNCTIONS: To provide leadership in advising and developing the Extension educational program in St. Louis County. To provide citizen input in the planning, implementing and obtaining support for the Extension programs. To represent the County in staff hiring, evaluation and development of financial resources for Extension programs.

DESIRED AREAS OF RESIDENCE: St. Louis County Commissioner Districts 1, 3, and 6, represented by Commissioners Frank Jewell, Chris Dahlberg, Keith Nelson respectively. Citizen members will be appointed by the County Board and generally geographically balanced across the county.
